TAXPAYERS' SAVINGS GRANTS PROGRAM 8 Sec. 42.501. GRANT PROGRAM. (a) The comptroller shall . 9 establish and administer a Taxpayers' Savings Grants Program 10 under which the parent or legal guardian of a school-age child 11 who resides in this state and who is entering kindergarten or 12 first grade or attended a public school during all of the school 13 year preceding the year of first participation in the program, 14 may apply for and receive a grant, to be used only for tuition 15 at a private elementary or secondary school in this state, that 16 17 is the lesser of: (1) the actual cost of tuition at the private school 18 19 the student attends; or (2) 60 percent of the average statewide public 20 education maintenance and operations expenditure per pupil. 21 (b) A grant awarded under the program is payable from the 22

Foundation School Program. A grant awarded under the program is

- 3 program, an individual may continue to receive a grant during
